Fletcher Mural Restoration Update

The mural restoration committee adopted "To restore, preserve and contribute to the education of the cultural heritage assets of U. S. Grant High School" as its mission statement before beginning the fundraising for the Fletcher Memorial Murals restoration in earnest last December. Our goal was to raise \$100,000 in six months in order to receive the generous match from the Leo Lester Browne Charitable Fund challenge. On April 20th, less than five months after the challenge began, we reached \$100,000. Donations continued to arrive.

YOU made it happen. It is an exhilarating feeling knowing your generosity meant we met and exceeded our challenge grant for the restoration of the historic Fletcher murals. These classic murals honoring the memory of Grant's first principal, have graced the school's auditorium for 87 years. Words cannot express our gratitude for the thoughtful donations each of you have made that, frankly, exceeded our expectations. THANK YOU!

More than 650 Grant alumni and supporters have contributed to the restoration project. The next phase of the restoration project will be the selection of a professional art conservator. Follow the progress of the mural restoration through the Grant Alumni Association website, www.grantalumni.org.

You may be wondering what will happen if there is money left over after the murals have been restored. Our agreement with the Leo Lester Browne Charitable Fund obligates us to exhaust all donated funds before using the contribution from the charitable fund. Any balance will be used for scholarships, grants, or purchases of equipment to enhance the music program at Grant High School.

We will continue to accept donations for the mural restoration until all costs are known and covered. Four new inductees Elected to the Grant Alumni Assn. Hall of Achievement

Mildred Schwab, '33 was one of the first women to study law graduating in 1939 from Northwestern College of Law (Lewis & Clark). She organized a successful sit-in at a restaurant in the old Lipman Wolfe department store that was open to men only, and was part of a group of women who opened the City Club to women. She was appointed to Portland City Council in 1972 and reelected three times. Schwab died in 1999.



Ed Washington, '56 moved to the Irvington area after his family lost everything in the Vanport flood. While at Grant, Washington was Freshman boys league president, sophomore class president, played freshman and JV basketball, on the JV track team, and participated in Dramateurs.

After graduating from Grant, he worked for OHSU before attending and graduating from PSU in '74. In 1956 he joined the NAACP serving to end discriminatory hiring in local grocery stores. He was the Metro Council's first African-American Councilor. Last year PSU named Washington the recipient of the Nohad Toulon Urban Pioneer Award for Public Service.



Deborah Kafoury '85 was elected in 2008 to the Multnomah County Commission focusing on helping families in crisis find housing; replacing the Sellwood Bridge, and the Central Courthouse; and working with the city, state and federal officials to address homelessness, early education, and child abuse prevention. She was elected in 2013 as the Metro chair where she established a Joint Office of Homeless Services to work in partnership with the city on the housing crisis.



Mark Owen '77 was an honor student and award winning gymnast. After graduating from OSU he worked at Tektronix as a design engineer. He taught engineering at the University of Limerick while completing his master's degree in advanced manufacturing technology. After working for the Irish Dept. of Science and Technology he returned to Oregon working for Electro Scientific Industries. Wanting to solve the world water crisis, he founded Puralytics. Among other products, the company makes SolarBag, a solar water purifier. Owen was inducted into the OSU Engineering Hall of Fame in 2015.



2019 Rose Festival Princess Stella Montaverde-Cakebread

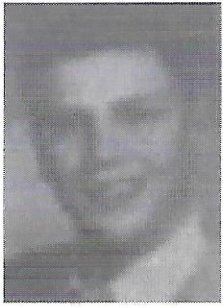

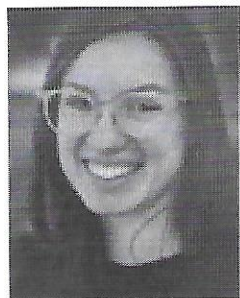
Gabriel J Hambrick Given the 2019 Alumni Scholarship

Although now an outgoing, enthusiastic young man, he struggled when first at Grant because he was new to the area and knew no one. He decided to play football and wrestle. Sports proved to be invaluable both for successes on the field and mat and for forging strong, special friendships. Gabe is fluent in Spanish, finished GHS with a 3.7 GPA and found time to work many hours at jobs away from school! Gabe is headed to George Fox University to study nursing where his sunny disposition will provide great bed side comfort to his patients. The Alvin A. Alexandre Scholarship

Jessica Griepenburg '19 is very grateful. Yes, she is graduating from Grant this month. Yes, she is headed for the school of her choice, Mills College in Oakland, California. But that isn't what's uppermost in her mind and heart. She is mainly grateful that she and her staff at *Grant Magazine* have been trusted as adults. "It has been so different than at many high schools where teachers and administrators still approve every story submitted to the school newspaper before publication—the young journalists made to feel they aren't experienced or mature enough for responsibility; at this school, there is no interference," she says.



That trust explains *Grant Magazine's* phenomenal success. For five years in a row—2014-2018—the monthly, 36-page, full-color magazine has received the Gold Crown for

overall excellence from the Columbia Scholastic Press Association <http://grantmagazine.com/>. Not only is it entirely student run, but it is also funded from subscriptions, donations and from the school community, and grants from Portland Public Schools.

Trust from elders isn't the only explanation of *Grant Magazine's* success. "We tell the stories of the community," Jessica explains, "especially those that are too often overlooked." Consider her recent contributions: stories about Grant students with mental health challenges, and stories of many students who can define the notion of consent but don't really understand what that notion means in the confusing situations of sexual interactions. Whether an issue of *Grant Magazine* explores use of the "N" word or homelessness or gentrification, it "taps the pulse," in Jessica's words, of the community of students, teachers, and parents of our high school.

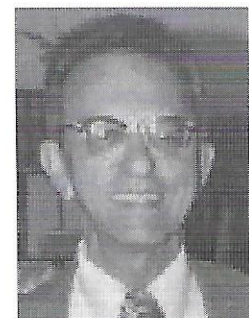
What excites Jessica about journalism is its ability to change the world. Not by persuading and certainly not by browbeating others into seeing one's own point of view, but by telling stories about where we have come from and what has caused us to feel and think as we do. There is power in storytelling to bring us together and into dialogue. Everyone has a story to tell, she says.

Jessica could be dispirited these days by charge and counter-charge in the war about "fake news." But she isn't. "It's not dispiriting but motivating," she says. "Polarization helps us focus on how we bridge the gap between people who disagree. Our answer at *Grant Magazine* is that we help overcome polarization by making it possible for people to tell the stories of their hopes, challenges, and unfulfilled dreams."

Jessica enjoys mentoring younger aspirants, and she would be happy some day to teach what she has learned. What would she teach—the importance of the five "w's" and the "h?" Her answer is unexpected and intriguing. "Journalism is about humility. It's not about by-lines and fame, but about the awe that a writer feels in the presence of a storyteller," she says.

By now you know enough about Jessica to figure out her choice of Mills College. "It's a small school where you can discuss issues with a dozen classmates," she says. While freedom of speech and all the fine points of law governing free speech are debated on today's campuses, it is more important to hear others' stories about how a course or a controversial issue intersects their lives, she believes.

One more thing Jessica is grateful about—the Alvin A. Alexandre scholarship that will be awarded her at graduation. That scholarship, which has been awarded to six students in the past four years, was established to honor a Grant High School journalism teacher who inspired dozens of young writers in the 1950s and 1960s. Can we extend the reach of this scholarship for other Jessica's in years to come? We certainly can. We can begin contributing to the scholarship fund in the fall when Grant journalism students will return to a refurbished building.
