Fletcher Mural Restoration Update

Most of you are aware by now of the mural restoration project to have the two Carl Hoeckner murals in the Grant auditorium restored.

What a surprise to receive an email from **Brad Owens '67** saying in part, "As a grad of the class of '67 I well remember these murals as I recall the many assemblies and classes I attended in the Grant auditorium. I do not recall anyone calling attention to or discussing the origins of the murals but they suggested a variety of motifs and purpose to the young mind. They are the only artwork I recall from my days at Grant and I would hope that they would be meaningful to the many generations that have seen them". He went on to offer a significant donation from a charitable fund that he oversees and proposed using the donation as a matching grant up to \$100,000.

On the first of December, the mural restoration committee sent letters and emails to kickoff the fundraising and have been overwhelmed with gratitude for the response. As of January 15, there have been more than 450 donations for a total of \$50,000. Thank you if you have already made your donation; and if not, the match is for a limited time so please donate now.

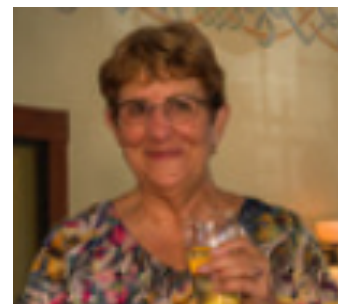
